Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District hires Education/Public Awareness Coordinator

The Lone Star Groundwater Conservation District has taken the next step towards building a stronger water efficiency ethic for Montgomery County with the creation and hiring of an Education/ Public Awareness Coordinator. The District is excited about securing a full time staff person dedicated to educating the public about water efficiency and the opportunity to provide information on implementing effective programs.

The District is pleased to announce the hiring of Marjie Risk, formerly the Statewide Water Conservation Coordinator for the Arizona Department of Water Resources (ADWR). Ms. Risk brings nearly 22 years of water experience to the District. During her tenure at the ADWR, she created Arizona's first water efficiency program aimed at commercial food service facilities and a statewide leak detection program. Ms. Risk is currently serving a second three year term on the American Water Works Association (AWWA) Water Conservation Division Board of Trustees and is the Division's Liaison to the AWWA Standards Council. Ms. Risk is currently leading a group of national water experts to develop a new water conservation standard to be used as a guideline for water and waste water treatment operators.
