By affixing my signature below, I hereby certify that:

- The above-identified LVGU (the "LVGU") recognizes and acknowledges that its Initial Conversion Obligation is, by calendar year 2016, to have reduced its groundwater production to no more than 70 percent of its Total Qualifying Demand and to have actually met not less than 30 percent of its Total Qualifying Demand by implementing conservation measures or by using an Alternative Water Source, or both;
The LVGU recognizes and acknowledges that Total Qualifying Demand means the final volume of groundwater that it was authorized to produce in calendar year 2009 under the terms of a permit issued by the District, as that final volume has been determined by the District after receipt of calendar year 2009 water production reports;
The LVGU recognizes and acknowledges that the District may reduce the LVGU's final production volume for 2009, by amending its applicable permits, if and to the extent the District determines that the amount previously authorized in the permit unreasonably exceeded the 2009 groundwater demand of the LVGU;
The LVGU recognizes and acknowledges that the District may require further reductions in groundwater production from the LVGU beyond the level initially required in the DPR Phase II(B); and
The signatory swears and affirms that it has the authority to sign on behalf of, and otherwise bind, the LVGU for purposes of this Declaration of Intent.
